Music Options at LMS - Please read this thoroughly BEFORE completing the form!

CHORUS:

The chorus program in Montgomery is an amazing way to engage in music and have a great time singing! All students are welcome to select chorus as their music option. Every student has a singing voice! The LMS chorus classes also participate in a field trip to NYC to hear some of the world's greatest professional singers! If you do not play an instrument in the band or orchestra, singing is the most accessible way to quickly enjoy making music!

BAND:

Band is where you can play a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument. If you already learned a band instrument, we strongly recommend you continue with band next year at LMS! All band rehearsals and lessons happen as part of the band class during the school day. As such there are no beforeschool rehearsals or missed class time for weekly lessons. Please note that students may not switch instruments without the consent of a music teacher. Students who do not play a band instrument but wish to learn may do so as beginners! Available beginning instruments to learn are: flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone, baritone, or percussion. One of our band teachers will meet with beginning students to help them select which instrument is appropriate for them. Parents of beginning students, please do not invest in an instrument rental or purchase before this happens. While beginning an instrument at LMS is possible, we typically recommend that students who have not played an instrument before choose chorus as this allows them to engage in making music right away.

ORCHESTRA:

Orchestra is where you can continue learning to play a string instrument, including violin, viola, cello, or bass. If you learned a string instrument previously, we strongly recommend you continue with orchestra next year at LMS! All orchestra rehearsals and lessons happen as part of the orchestra class during the school day. As such there are no before-school rehearsals or missed class time for weekly lessons. Please note that students may not switch instruments without the consent of one of the orchestra teachers. Students who do not play a string instrument but wish to learn may do so! Available beginning instruments to learn are: viola, cello, or bass. Violin is not an option for beginning students. Dr. Goldman or Mrs. Kilgore will meet with beginning students to help them select which instrument to play. Parents of beginning students, please do not invest in an instrument rental or purchase before this happens. While beginning an instrument at LMS is possible, we typically recommend that students who have not played an instrument before choose chorus as this allows them to engage in making music right away.

MUSIC WORKSHOP:

Music Workshop is a music appreciation class that covers music reading, music history, and music composition. Students will have the opportunity to learn about and compose original music. In 5th grade, students will learn to play the recorder as well.

Also, while beginning an instrument is allowed, our recommendation for students who wish to be in a performing ensemble and do not play a band/orchestra instrument is to join the chorus as this will allow them to engage in music making immediately.
