As a reminder, or for those of you who are new to MHS, Montgomery360 is a program that is designed to help students develop and maintain their social and emotional learning skills. The program curriculum consists of short lessons delivered to students each month in internet-connected devices. Each lesson will help students through a variety of methods, including videos, games, quizzes, and articles. The program is provided by Evolution Labs/Suite 360. We have tailored the program for our students at MHS and it is referred to as "Montgomery360."
