

- Students will always remain in groups of at least 3 or more
- All travelers will have international cellular plans and students will have phone numbers of chaperones
- Luggage checks prior to departure and nightly room checks
- MTSD staff will visit all sites and hotels in advance for inspection

CANCELLATION POLICY

Our tour company has provided the following refund schedule:

- Cancellations before 9/15/24 full refund
- Cancellations before 10/15/24 \$300 cancellation fee
- Cancellations before 12/15/24 \$600 cancellation fee
- Cancellations before 2/13/25 \$900 cancellation fee
- Cancellations after 2/13/25 minimum of \$1,200 but may be charged up to 100% of the total per person tour price, as determined by our tour company (TRC) in its sole discretion

Please note: These cancellation fees do not include any airline-imposed cancellation fees which may apply and differ depending upon the airline we contract with and the date of cancellation.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The tour company (TRC) considers the date of your cancellation to be the date they are notified of the cancellation in writing. If you need to cancel the trip, please notify us in writing by emailing all of the following:

TRAVEL INSURANCE CANCEL FOR ANY REASON - CFAR

There are multiple options for travel insurance that will be outlined for you in our travel portal (we will show you this later in the presentation). We recommend all students purchase "Cancel for Any Reason" travel insurance (CFAR). With this insurance, should you need to cancel participation in the trip beyond the date where a refund is possible, this policy will reimburse you 75% of the tour cost.

• Please note that the Montgomery School District may cancel this trip at any time for safety reasons not limited to, but including an increase in concerns surrounding COVID-19 and that should this happen, the district will not be able to reimburse any lost payments. Depending upon when this happens in relation to our tour company's cancellation policy, the cost of the trip may be irrecoverable. The "cancel for any reason" travel insurance policy may be your only avenue for recuperating some of the funds (75% of your cost) in this event.

PASSPORTS AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

All students must have a valid passport and for students who are not US Citizens, appropriate travel documentation. Please note the following:

- Passports must be valid at least 6 months after our date of return
- We will collect images of all passports to keep with us while traveling
- Passports will be collected from students once we are through immigration and kept by chaperones during the trip
- For non-US Citizens, it is your responsibility to verify with the appropriate consulate/embassy what travel documents are needed for travel between the US and Ireland
- If appropriate passports/documents are not obtained in time for the trip,
 the student will not be able to participate and refunds may not be possible
