

Portrait of a Graduate

HIB Statute Review

"Harassment, intimidation or bullying":

- Any gesture
- Any written, verbal or physical act, or electronic communication
- Whether it be a single incident or a series of incidents
- That is reasonably perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic
- That takes place on school property, at any school-sponsored function, on a school bus, or off school grounds

The HIB must *substantially disrupt or interfere* with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students and at least one:

- Areasonable person should know, under the circumstances, the act will have the effect of physically or emotionally harming a student or damaging a student's property, or placing a student in reasonable fear of physical or emotional harm to his person or damage to his property; **or**
- Has the effect of insulting or demeaning any student or group of students; **or**
- Creates a hostile educational environment for the student by interfering with a student's education **or** by severely or pervasively causing physical or emotional harm to the student.

Anti-Bullying Specialists

Anti-Bullying Specialists (ABS) complete mandated training in the areas of:

- HIB law
- Protocols
- Conducting interviews, and investigations
- State/district mandated trainings

Anti-Bullying Specialists chair the building school safety/climate teams and develop and implement trainings and programs that foster and maintain a positive school climate. Anti-Bullying Specialists (ABS)


