There is positive energy throughout the district which extends into our full-day kindergarten initiative. Information about full-day kindergarten can be found on our <u>website</u>. The opportunity for our district to provide a full-day kindergarten is one of the most beneficial programs we can offer to our future students. Please take the time to explore all the advantages this initiative will provide. The Board of Education is hosting a Town Hall on Full-day Kindergarten on Monday, October 10, 2022, from 5:30-7:00 PM at the OHES West Gym. There will also be a tour of a model classroom at the future Early Childhood Center.

The health curriculum was completed this summer and can be reviewed through the district's website. The curriculum documents allow families to identify which topics are taught in each grade level and explore sample resources at various grade levels.
