Wednesday 3/05: Wacky Wednesday!

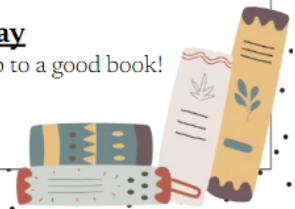
Dress up in your wackiest clothes (mismatched colors, patterns, socks, shoes, etc.)
