

HIB: Statutory Definition

“HIB” means any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or any electronic communication, whether it be a single incident or series of incidents that:



HIB: Statutory Definition

1. Is reasonably perceived as being motivated by either any actual or perceived characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristic; **AND that**
2. Takes place on school property, at any school sponsored function, on a school bus, or off school grounds that
 - a) substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or
 - b) the rights of other students; **AND that**



HIB: Statutory Definition

3. One of the following

- a. A reasonable person should know, under the circumstances, that the act(s) will have the effect of physically or emotionally harming a student or damaging the student's property, or placing a student in a reasonable fear of physical or emotional harm to his/her person or damage to his/her property; or
- b. Has the effect of insulting or demeaning any student or group of students; or
- c. Creates a hostile educational environment for the student by interfering with a student's education or by severely or pervasively causing physical or emotional harm to the student.



2019-2020 Total Reported and Affirmed






